Rifle Event Outline – 8:30am Start - Warm up – 3 shots in 3 Minutes at 300 metres.</p> <p>Event 5 - SSAA 300m DELIBERATE - Match 9 - (Std. iron & Mod. sights rifle – 10 rounds in 6 minutes).</p> <p>Event 6 - SSAA 3P CORE EVENT - Match 1 - (Std. iron & Mod. sights rifle – 30 rounds WALK UP).</p> <p>Event 7 - SSAA ACTION ‘M’ 100mts - Match 12 - (Std. iron & Mod. sights rifle – 10rounds).</p> <p>Break for lunch at approx. 12:00noon, then;</p> <p>Optical Rifle Event Outline – To be shot at 500 metres.</p> <p>Event 8 - 500m Sniper/Tactical Deliberate/Snaps – Optical Rifle (any other welcome) (front rest only) – 33 rounds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3 sighting shoots, each shot marked on 4x4 Type C Target. - 10 rounds in 6 minutes (no marking), then - 10x3 second exposures, single snap, 10 rounds on appearing 4x4 type C targets, then - 5x6 second exposures, double snap, 10 rounds on appearing 4x4 type C targets. <p align="center">This competition is part of the NSW Pistol, Cadet & Rifle Grand Prix Series, but also an open event made up of local events plus SSAA sanctioned matches in accordance with the National Discipline Rulebook.</p>
