

**S.S.A.A. NSW MILITARY SERVICE DISCIPLINE
MARTINI CADET / .22 TRAINER OPEN POSTAL SHOOT
March to June 2009 inclusive.**

The event will run from March to June 2009. Entries must be on the official score sheet by July 10th, 2009, as the results will be announced at the NSW Military Service Discipline State Championships. Course of fire and info: Firearms to be externally original Martini Cadet and/or .22 Trainer rifles, in any similar military/service calibre and must be within the spirit of the discipline (not carry explicit target modifications). In case of doubt, please contact the organisers. Shooters will fire 30 rounds as follows:

10 rounds, offhand at 25 metres, with a time limit of 5 minutes,

10 rounds, seated/squatted/kneeling at 50 metres, with a time limit of 5 minutes,

10 rounds, prone unsupported at 75 metres, with a time limit of 5 minutes.

Target is the standard 25/50 metre precision pistol target – scoring 1 to 10 with an X ring and an 8” black aiming mark on a white square screen. Scoring will be ‘best edge’ true scoring as per the target, offering a possible of 300.30 (good luck if you can get that!). X ring will be used to eliminate tied scores by scoring as 10.01.

Competitors simply submit their best Martini Cadet / .22 Trainer 3 range match score shot during this period. Scores are to be submitted, either via snail mail or electronically, by club military/service discipline captains, or via club/branch range officers. Submitted scores must show competitor’s name, SSAA Branch, state, and the score values of all 30 shots. A complimentary scoresheet is available from the NSW discipline website however, any method to submit the recorded scores as required will be acceptable, so long as it has the range officers signature on it. Results will be posted on the NSW discipline website for shooters to review.

Disputes must be in writing to the State Chairperson by July 17th, 2009 and thereafter results will be final.
